FOREIGN INVESTMENT

R e s o l u t i o n

adopted by the Council at its 65th Meeting
on December 3rd and 4th, 1946

Pending the publication in the Spring 1947 of its full recommendation
and report on foreign investment, the International Chamber of Commerce
draws the urgent attention of governments and of the Preparatory Committee
of the International Conference on Trade and Employment to the following
three points:

1. The future Charter of the International Trade Organization should
include a section dealing with the question of international capital
movements;
2. Provision should be made in the Charter for the elaboration and
adoption of a Code of Fair Practice in the field of foreign investment;
3. Suitable machinery should be set up, within the I.T.O., to
implement the operation of the code of fair practice.
