CHECK LIST AND INDEX OF DOCUMENTS, THROUGH FEBRUARY 1947

A. Introduction

The Committee on Arrangements for Consultation with Non-governmental Organizations was first established as an ad hoc Committee by a resolution of the Economic and Social Council (1) adopted at its eleventh plenary meeting, 16 February 1946 (2). The Committee was composed of the President of the Council and representatives in the Council of China, Cuba, France, Greece, Lebanon, Peru, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, the United Kingdom, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United States of America, and Yugoslavia. The Committee made its first report (E/43) to the second session of the Council, which considered the report at its twenty-third plenary meeting, 7 June 1946, and sent the report back to the Committee for reconsideration (3). The Council approved the amended report (4) at its twenty-seventh plenary meeting, 21 June 1946 (5).

The Committee report recommended that a standing Committee on Arrangements for Consultation with Non-governmental Organizations (short title: Council NGO Committee) should be appointed, to be composed of the President and five members of the Council. The Council elected China, France, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom, and the

United States of America at its twenty-eighth plenary meeting, 21 June 1946 (6). The Council further decided at its fortieth plenary meeting, 28 September 1946 (7) that the Council NGO Committee should be the standing committee recommended in the committee report to carry on consultations with organizations given consultative status (8). The Council NGO Committee made its second report (E/189/Rev.2) recommending the granting of consultative status to the International Chamber of Commerce and making other recommendations. The Council approved the report and accompanying resolution (9) at its forty-fourth plenary meeting, 1 October 1946 (10).
