REGULATION, LIMITATION AND BALANCED REDUCTION OF ALL ARMED FORCES AND ALL ARMAMENTS: CONCLUSION OF AN INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION (TREATY) ON THE REDUCTION OF ARMAMENTS AND THE PROHIBITION OF ATOMIC, HYDROGEN AND CIMER VEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

Canada, India, Japan, Sweden and Yugoslavia: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 502(VI) establishing the Disarmament Commission,

- 1. <u>Decides</u> to enlarge the Disarmament Commission by the addition of fourteen Member States which, for the first year, from 1 January 1958 to 1 January 1959, shall be: Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Burma, Czecholosvakia, Egypt, India, Italy, Mexico, Norway, Poland, Tunisia and Yugoslavia;
- 2. Transmits to the Disarmament Commission the records of the proceedings of the First Committee at which disarmament was discussed.
