## Letter dated 27 April 2020 from the Permanent Representative of Jordan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit a statement of solidarity and appreciation to the City of New York (see annex), which was initiated by Jordan and garnered the support of 167 Member States and observers.

The statement expresses our full solidarity and appreciation for the City of New York – the host city of the United Nations and home of our collective voice for peace, prosperity and solidarity – as it faces the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), one of its biggest challenges in decades. It also extends deep appreciation and gratitude to the heroes and sheroes of New York City, and recognizes the dedication and courage of its leadership, health-care workers, police, firefighters and brave essential workers and salutes them for putting their lives at risk every day, to save our own. The statement expresses the shared commitment of all 167 signatories to stand in unity with the City of New York as we collectively work to defeat this unconventional enemy.

We kindly request that the present letter and its annex be transmitted to the host country and to the relevant authorities of New York City on behalf of the 167 signatories and be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 123.

We extend our deep appreciation and gratitude to the heroes and sheroes of New York City, who put their lives at risk every day, to save our own. Without the dedication and courage of New Yorkers – leadership, health-care workers, police, firefighters and brave essential workers – this time of uncertainty would have been far more difficult. We salute them all.

We offer our deepest condolences for the loss of life that New York City has endured from the virus. Those who passed will remain in our hearts and prayers. Our thoughts and prayers are also with those who are battling this vicious disease.

We, the representatives of our nations to the United Nations, have come to know the spirit of New York City. We know the strength of its people. We know that New Yorkers will win over this vicious enemy. We share our commitment and stand in unity with the City of New York as we collectively work to defeat this unconventional enemy. And we will defeat it.
