PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1976-1977

Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator

Financing of emergency relief assistance and technical co-operation activities

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, in resolution 3532 (XXX) requested the Secretary-General to report annually on the status of the trust fund established pursuant to General Assembly resolution 3243 (XXX) of 29 November 1974 on strengthening the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator.
- 2. It will be recalled that resolution 3243 (XXIX) called upon the Secretary-General to provide sufficient staff, equipment and facilities to strengthen the capacity of the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator to provide an efficient and effective world-wide service of mobilizing and co-ordinating disaster relief, including particularly the collection and dissemination of information on disaster assessment, priority needs and donor assistance. It decided that the additional costs of providing this strengthened capability should be met by voluntary contributions during the period 1975-1977, with the understanding that the additional resources made available under the terms of resolution 3243 (XXIX) should be concentrated on strengthening the co-ordinating capability of the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator, but without prejudice to any improvements that could be made in the roles of that Office in disaster prevention and pre-disaster planning within the resources otherwise available to it.
- 3. By resolution 3532 (XXX) the General Assembly decided to establish two new subaccounts within the trust fund established pursuant to General Assembly resolution 3243 (XXIX).
- (a) to augment the funds available under the regular budget for emergency assistance;

- (b) to provide programme costs of technical assistance in disaster prevention and pre-disaster planning assistance to Governments.
- 4. The resolution provided the subaccount for emergency assistance with a target figure of \$400,000 for the biennium 1976/77 to supplement the amount of \$400,000, provided under the regular budget, while, for the subaccount for technical assistance a target figure of \$600,000 for the biennium was given.
- 5. For the nine-month period ended 30 September 1976, the activity in the three subaccounts comprising the trust fund may be summarized as follows:

- 6. The figures shown above for income and expenditures are elaborated in the attached annex.
- 7. It will be noted from the above that no income is shown under the subaccount for emergency assistance. Although no contributions were received for this particular subaccount, the Office of the Disaster Relief Co-ordinator received and expended in excess of \$1 million in voluntary funds earmarked for particular disaster situations. These activities have been reported separately to the General Assembly in document A/31/88 and Add.1.
- 8. It may be of interest to add that as of 30 September 1976 \$150,000 had been committed from the regular budget provision of \$400,000 for the biennium for emergency assistance, in the following amounts:
