CORRIGENDUM TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE FIFTY-FIRST MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York,
on Wednesday, 23 March 1949, at 3.10 p.m.

Page 13, last paragraph, replace the text of Mr. Evans' speech by the following text:

"Mr. EVANS (International Labour Organization) recalled that at its last session the Sub-Commission had received a document drawn up by the ILO which referred directly to the subject under discussion.

"There were grounds for emphasizing the necessity for using to the full the domestic resources of the country with a view to increasing its productiveness and thus raising its standard of living as much as possible. Mention should be made of that point in the Sub-Commission's report.

"Moreover, if the social aims visualized in the United Nations Charter (namely the raising of the standards of living and economic and social development) were sought, the resources thus mobilized should be used for industrial and agricultural development and not wasted, as had happened more than once, on the import of luxury objects, for example."
