Letter dated 22 November 1955 from the President of the General Assembly
to the Chairman of the Sixth Committee

I have been informed by the Chairman of the Third Committee that, in connexion with its consideration of the agenda item entitled "Draft convention on the nationality of married women", the Committee decided to request the Sixth Committee to study articles 4 to 11 of the convention, as well as the amendments which have been proposed to these articles. I understand the Committee took this decision in view of the legal aspects involved in the matter.

The Third Committee hopes that your Committee might be able to undertake the study of these articles and to report to the General Assembly at an early date, since it is desired that the draft convention should be adopted at the present session.
