SCALE OF ASSESSMENTS FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF THE UNITED NATIONS: REPORT OF THE COMPLETED ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Japan: druft proposal

The 1956 assessment for Japan, admitted to membership in the United Nations on 18 December 1956, should be one-minth of its percentage assessment for 1957, and not one-third, as suggested by the Committee on Contributions (A/3714, paragraph 18).

In consequence of the above, the amount that Japan is called upon to contribute under resolution 970 (X), paragraph 4, by reason of participation in certain United Nations activities before admission of Japan to membership, would be reduced by one-ninth and not by one-third (A/3714, paragraph 19).
