## Momorandum by tho Socretary-Genoral

The Secretary-Generel has the honour to placo before the General Comittee certain observations and auggostions regarding the arrangemente for the mootings of tho Generol Aasembly and ita Main Comatteea during the fourth ceseion.

## Schgdule of meetinge

1. It is auggestod thet both plenary and commttoe metinge ahould begin ot $10.45 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$, and $3.00 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. In vicw of the heavy programme, it is urged that delegations make overy effort to arrive at the scheduled mooting ploce on timo.
2. It is proposed that a oix-doy working woek be ostablishod, and thot night meetinge be held whenever necessary.
3. Plenary meetings will bo held in tho General Acsembly Hall at Flughing Meadow. The Main Committoes will meet in the Conference Rooms at Lake Success. The General Comitteo will be schoduled to moot in Conference Room $\Lambda$ in the General Asaembly building at Flushing Meadow or at Lake Succese as appropriato.
4. The Secretary-General has mode arrangemente for the servicing of four Main Cormittees meeting oimultonoously. He wishes to auggest that in the initial etaces of the Comittoes' work four Main Comittees be coheduled to moet each morning and four each afternoon.

5. Tho Sccretary-General wishes to ougge日t that the Ceneral Cormittee propose to the General Aasembly 30 November 1949 as the target dato for the cicsing of the fourth bession.

6. To facilitate the planning of the total programe of work of the General Ageombly the Secretary-General suggeate that the General Comittee recomend that a date be determined after which requesta for the inclusion of additionsl
iteme in the agenda of the seasion should not he made. If it is desired to adopt such a procodure, the Secretary-General proposes 4 october for such a deadline.

## Scating arrangements

7. At a recent Secrotaxy-General's ataff meeting lots wero drawn to choose the Member to occupy the firet deak on the Assombly Floor from which the alphabetical seating order will begin. Denmark was the name draw and consequently Denmark will ait at the first desk at the extreme right of the President. At tho initial mectings of the Main Committees the same seating ordor will be obcerved. Thore will be, however, a dally rotation of one place in the Main Comittees thereafter.
