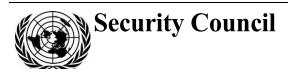

Report of Bosnia and Herzegovina on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

The Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in keeping with the obligations under paragraph 8 of resolution 2397 (2017), has the honour to advise that no national of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea was granted a temporary stay in Bosnia and Herzegovina on the basis of employment during the period beginning 15 months after the adoption of the resolution. Accordingly, no national of that country was repatriated in that period.

Bosnia and Herzegovina wishes to state that, to the best of its knowledge, as at 4 March 2020, no nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea were present in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina who met the conditions for repatriation in paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017). This is the final report for the period ending 27 months from the adoption of resolution 2397 (2017).
