General discussion: calendar of conferences and meetings

Draft revised calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2021

Note by the Secretariat

1. By section I, paragraphs 2 and 3, of its resolution [74/252](#) on the pattern of conferences, the General Assembly approved the draft calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2020, as submitted by the Committee on Conferences ([A/74/32](#), annex II), and amended by subsequent decisions taken by the Assembly at its seventy-fourth session. The approved calendar was issued as document [A/AC.172/2020/2](#).

2. In General Assembly resolution [72/266 A](#), the Assembly approved the change from a biennial to an annual budget cycle on a trial basis, beginning with the programme budget for 2020, and in resolution [3491 \(XXX\)](#) it decided that the cycle of meetings and conferences should coincide with the budgetary period. In the annex to the present note, the Secretariat submits for consideration by the Committee a draft revised calendar of conferences and meetings for 2021. The schedule reflects a number of changes already made during the course of 2020, in particular due to the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic and the limitations recommended on meetings within the United Nations premises as precautionary measures aimed at containing the spread of COVID-19 (see General Assembly decision [74/544](#), of 27 March 2020). Other changes for which decisions have yet to be taken or that have yet to be communicated to the Secretariat will be incorporated at a later stage.

3. In considering the draft revised calendar for 2021, the Committee may wish to note in particular the following decisions that have been taken to postpone meetings:

(a) Item 56, “Open-ended Working Group on Ageing”. In the light of the situation related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Chair has decided to postpone the eleventh session to a later date;

(b) Item 66, “Disarmament Commission, substantive session”. In its decision [74/546](#), of 2 April 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its decision [74/511](#) of



12 December 2019, in which it had decided that the Disarmament Commission would hold a substantive session for a period not exceeding three weeks during 2020, namely from 6 to 24 April, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), decided to postpone the substantive session of the Disarmament Commission to a period in 2021 to be decided by the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session;

(c) Items 87 and 158, “International Law Commission”. Pursuant to decision 74/559, of 23 June 2020, the General Assembly, recalling decision 74/545 of 2 April 2020, in which it had decided to postpone the first part of the seventy-second session, and to extend by one week the second part of the session so that it would run from 29 June to 7 August 2020, further decided that, taking into account the continuing situation concerning COVID-19, the seventy-second session of the International Law Commission should be postponed to a later date;

(d) Item 113, “Economic and Social Council, High-level Segment, Development Cooperation Forum”. The Council, pursuant to its resolution 2020/3, deferred the biennial forum to the 2021 session;

(e) Item 326, “Biennial Meeting of States to Consider the Implementation of the Programme of Action to Prevent, Combat and Eradicate the Illicit Trade in Small Arms and Light Weapons in All Its Aspects, seventh session”. Pursuant to decision 74/552, of 14 May 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 74/60 of 12 December 2019, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, decided to postpone the biennial meeting of States, scheduled for 15 to 19 June 2020 to a period in 2021 to be decided by the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session;

(f) Item 332, “Conference of States Parties and Signatories of Treaties that Establish Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zones and Mongolia, fourth conference”. Pursuant to its decision 74/549, of 13 April 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 73/71 of 5 December 2018, in which it had decided to convene the fourth Conference of Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zones and Mongolia as a one-day conference at United Nations Headquarters in New York on 24 April 2020, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), decided to postpone the Conference to a period in 2021 to be decided by the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session;

(g) Item 337, “High-level Committee on South-South Cooperation, twentieth session”. Pursuant to decision 74/543, of 14 May 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 71/318 of 28 August 2017 and its decision 73/553 of 9 May 2019, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID 19) pandemic, decided to postpone the twentieth session of the High-level Committee on South-South Cooperation to a later date;

(h) Item 340, “Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons”. In the light of the situation related to the COVID-19 pandemic, States Parties have decided to postpone the 2020 Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons to a later date, as soon as the circumstances permit, but no later than April 2021;

(i) Item 350, “United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development”. Pursuant to decision 74/548, of 13 April 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 73/292 of 9 May 2019, in which it had decided to convene the 2020 United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development in Lisbon,

from 2 to 6 June 2020, to support the implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), decided to postpone the Conference to a later date, to be decided by the General Assembly. The General Assembly also decided to set, at a later stage, the new deadlines for its preparatory process;

(j) Item 351, “United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, Fourteenth session”. Pursuant to its decision 74/550, of 13 April 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 73/184 of 17 December 2018, in which it had decided to hold the Fourteenth United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice in Kyoto, Japan, from 20 to 27 April 2020, with pre-Congress consultations to be held on 19 April 2020, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), decided to postpone the holding of the Fourteenth Congress until further notice and to consider new dates in due course;

(k) Item 2 in annex B, “United Nations Open-ended Informal Consultative Process on Oceans and the Law of the Sea, Twenty-first meeting”. Pursuant to decision 74/555, of 15 May 2020, the General Assembly, recalling its resolution 74/19 of 10 December 2019, in which it had requested the Secretary-General to convene, in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 of resolution 54/33 of 24 November 1999, the twenty-first meeting of the United Nations Open-ended Informal Consultative Process on Oceans and the Law of the Sea, in New York for eight meetings during the week of 22 to 26 June 2020, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, decided to postpone the twenty-first meeting of the Informal Consultative Process to 2021, to be held at a date to be decided by the General Assembly.

4. It should be noted that, in drafting the revised calendar, due regard has been taken of General Assembly resolution 53/208, in particular its paragraph 11, and paragraph 6 of Assembly resolution 74/252, in which it was decided that United Nations bodies should be invited to avoid holding meetings on Orthodox Good Friday, Yom Kippur, the Day of Vesak, Diwali, Gurpurab, Orthodox Christmas and Nowruz and that these arrangements should be taken into account when drafting future calendars of conferences and meetings. In 2021, these days occur on the dates set out in the table below, pending final confirmation from the Office of Human Resources of the Secretariat.
