DRAFT CONVENTION ON SPECIAL MISSIONS

Freamble: text adopted by the Prafting Committee

CONVENTION ON SPECIAL MISSIONS

The States Parties to the present Convention,

Recalling that special treatment has always been accorded to special missions,

Having in mind the Purposes and Principles of the Charter of the Unitel Nations concerning the sovereign equality of States, the maintenance of international peace and security and the development of friendly relations and co-operation among States,

Recalling that the importance of the question of special missions was recognized during the United Nations Conference on Diplomatic Intercourse and Immunities and in resolution I adopted by the Conference on 10 April 1901,

Considering that the United Nations Conference on Piplomatic Intercourse and Immunities adopted the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations which was opened for signature on 16 April 1901,

Considering that the United Nations Conference on Consular Relations adopted the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations which was opened for signature on 24 April 1965,

Relieving that an international convention on special missions would complement those two Conventions and would contribute to the development of friendly relations among nations, whatever their constitutional and social systems,

Realizing that the purpose of privileges and immunities is not to benefit individuals but to ensure the efficient performance of the functions of special missions as missions representing the State,

Affirming that the rules of customary international law continue to govern questions not regulated by the provisions of the present Convention,

Have agreed as follows:
