Paragraph 28 should read

The democratic processes related to regular electoral cycles, approvals of the government budgets and changes in the composition of the cabinet of ministries could have an impact on the continued implementation of government programmes. Similarly, this could have an impact in driving new initiatives forward and securing co-financing for UNDP programmes. UNDP will mitigate these challenges by maintaining continuous dialogue with the Government and partners, conducting regular political economy and context analysis, and introducing adaptive measures to programming when needed. UNDP will support the Government in delivering services in times of uncertainty when government mechanisms could be disrupted due to global pandemics and/or other internal and external factors.
