Letter dated 31 August 2020 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that your letter dated 27 August 2020 (S/2020/868) with reference to Security Council resolution 2524 (2020), in which the Council requested that you report every 90 days on the implementation of the mandate of the United Nations Integrated Transition Assistance Mission in the Sudan (UNITAMS) and include in the first report clear and measurable core and contextual benchmarks and indicators to track progress made by the Mission against the strategic objectives and enable early planning for a future reconfiguration of the United Nations presence in the Sudan, has been brought to the attention of the members of the Council.

The members of the Council have taken note of the request contained in your letter that the time frame for the submission of the first quarterly report be extended for two weeks and that the submission of the suggested structure and geographical deployment of UNITAMS, as well as the quarterly report on the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur, be annexed to that report.
