Status of implementation of the Intergovernmental Agreement on the Trans-Asian Railway Network (E/ESCAP/TARN/WG(5)/1)

Annotation

The Working Group will be informed of the current status of the Intergovernmental Agreement on the Trans-Asian Railway Network with regard to the number of signatories and parties to the Agreement and the obligations of the parties. Member States may wish to update the Working Group on the progress made towards ratification, acceptance, accession to or approval of the Agreement. Member States may also wish to update the Working Group on ongoing or planned projects to develop or upgrade the Trans-Asian Railway network in their respective territories.

Annotation

Parties to the Intergovernmental Agreement on the Trans-Asian Railway Network have been invited to submit their proposals for amending the Agreement. The Working Group will consider the proposals received from member States in accordance with articles 7, 8 and 9 of the Agreement.

6. Policies and issues relating to the development of the Trans-Asian Railway network

Policies and issues relating to the development of the Trans-Asian Railway network (E/ESCAP/TARN/WG(5)/3)

Annotation

The Working Group will be informed of the decisions of legislative bodies relevant to the Trans-Asian Railway network and the work of the secretariat with member States in respect of the Trans-Asian Railway network. Member States are invited to circulate information materials on the progress on and plans for developing Trans-Asian Railway routes within their territory. The Working Group may share and consider policies and

approaches for (1) promoting investment in the Trans-Asian Railway network; (2) using the Trans-Asian Railway network as a driver of seamless connectivity in the region; (3) launching international intermodal services along the routes of the Trans-Asian Railway network; (4) integrating the Trans-Asian Railway network with maritime ports and dry ports; and (5) keeping the secretariat informed of priority development projects.

7. Building the missing links in the Trans-Asian Railway network

Documentation

Building the missing links in the Trans-Asian Railway network (E/ESCAP/TARN/WG(5)/4)

Annotation

The routes of the Trans-Asian Railway network already offer conduits for the movement of international trade. However, the operational capability of the network varies widely between subregions. In particular, a number of missing links still prevent the full realization of the network's potential to provide a solid basis for the development of international intermodal corridors reaching all corners of the region. The Working Group will receive from member States an update on the status of Trans-Asian Railway missing links in their respective countries and on the ongoing as well as planned actions being implemented or envisaged to construct them.

8. Perspectives and challenges in operationalizing the Trans-Asian Railway network

Perspectives and challenges in operationalizing the Trans-Asian Railway network (E/ESCAP/TARN/WG(5)/5)

Annotation

The Working Group will be informed about the ongoing implementation of Commission resolution 71/7 on the adoption of the Regional Cooperation Framework for the Facilitation of International Railway Transport. In the resolution, the Commission expressed its support for the operationalization of the Trans-Asian Railway network by addressing key issues and promoting cooperation among member States for the facilitation of international railway transport. Member States may share current initiatives and proposed measures to address operational issues along the Trans-Asian Railway network, including, but not limited to, those identified in the Regional Cooperation Framework for the Facilitation of International Railway Transport.
