The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to the resolution 1718 (2006) and, with reference to its note verbale dated 18 June 2019 (S/AC.49/2019/35), has the honour to transmit herewith the final report of Myanmar on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) (see annex).

Report of Myanmar on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

The Security Council, in paragraph 8 of its resolution 2397 (2017), requires all Member States to submit a final report on all nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea earning income in that Member State's jurisdiction who were repatriated in compliance with resolution 2397 (2017).

By its note verbale dated 18 June 2019 (S/AC.49/2019/35), the Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar to the United Nations submitted its midterm report on measures taken by the Government of Myanmar to implement resolution 2397 (2017). The information contained in that report remains valid, and thus, the present final report should be read in conjunction with, and as a supplement to, the midterm implementation report. The Government continues to actively monitor its activities to ensure that they are not in breach of provisions stipulated in resolution 2397 (2017). Since the departure in March 2018 of 21 nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, who used to work at a now-defunct North Korean restaurant in Yangon, no nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea have been employed in Myanmar.

The Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar reaffirms its commitment to implement the resolutions of the Security Council relating to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.
