Letter dated 6 October 2020 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution [2541 \(2020\)](#), adopted on 31 August 2020, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Mali until 30 September 2021 and requested that I take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2374 \(2017\)](#) concerning Mali, I have appointed the following experts:

Mr. Albert Kwokwo Barume, regional (Democratic Republic of the Congo)
Ms. Sanaa Elhakim, humanitarian affairs (Egypt)
Mr. Ruben de Koning, finance (Netherlands)
Mr. Aurélien Llorca, armed groups (France)

I have designated Mr. Barume to serve as the Coordinator of the Panel.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
