7. Over a decade of violent conflict across north-eastern Nigeria has resulted in one of the most severe humanitarian crises globally. Civilians are significantly affected by improvised explosive devices, including person-borne devices and vehicle-borne devices deployed by some factions of Boko Haram. At the time of drafting of the present report, person-borne devices had killed 76 civilians and injured 150. In addition, the presence of victim-operated improvised explosive devices, also known as anti-personnel mines of an improvised nature, along main roads continues to disrupt humanitarian assistance.
