## Draft budget proposals of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea for the budget period 2021–2022

## Addendum

1. In the draft budget proposals of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea for the budget period 2021–2022 (SPLOS/30/5), the budget line "Pension for retiring judges" provides the amount of  $\notin$ 802,000 for seven judges whose term of office expires in September 2020, for a period of 24 months. Following the re-election of two judges in August 2020, the proposed amount may be reduced by  $\notin$ 208,000 to  $\notin$ 594,000 to provide for five judges for a period of 24 months.

2. The proposed amount for the budget line "Pension in payment" amounts to  $\epsilon$ 1,424,600 for 11 former judges and for 8 surviving spouses. In the light of the death of one former judge, the amount may be reduced by  $\epsilon$ 49,400 to  $\epsilon$ 1,375,200 to provide for 10 former judges and 9 surviving spouses.

3. As a consequence, the proposed amount for section 2 "Judges' pension scheme" may be reduced by  $\notin$  257,400 to  $\notin$  1,969,200.
