Draft budget proposals of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea for the budget period 2021–2022

Addendum

1. In the draft budget proposals of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea for the budget period 2021–2022 (SPLOS/30/5), the budget line "Pension for retiring judges" provides the amount of \notin 802,000 for seven judges whose term of office expires in September 2020, for a period of 24 months. Following the re-election of two judges in August 2020, the proposed amount may be reduced by \notin 208,000 to \notin 594,000 to provide for five judges for a period of 24 months.

2. The proposed amount for the budget line "Pension in payment" amounts to ϵ 1,424,600 for 11 former judges and for 8 surviving spouses. In the light of the death of one former judge, the amount may be reduced by ϵ 49,400 to ϵ 1,375,200 to provide for 10 former judges and 9 surviving spouses.

3. As a consequence, the proposed amount for section 2 "Judges' pension scheme" may be reduced by \notin 257,400 to \notin 1,969,200.
