United States of America: draft resolution

The Security Council,

Recalling its previous resolutions on Haiti, in particular its resolutions [2476 \(2019\)](#), [2466 \(2019\)](#), [2410 \(2018\)](#), [2350 \(2017\)](#), [2313 \(2016\)](#), [2243 \(2015\)](#), [2180 \(2014\)](#), [2119 \(2013\)](#), [2070 \(2012\)](#), [2012 \(2011\)](#), [1944 \(2010\)](#), [1927 \(2010\)](#), [1908 \(2010\)](#), [1892 \(2009\)](#), [1840 \(2008\)](#), [1780 \(2007\)](#), [1743 \(2007\)](#), [1702 \(2006\)](#), [1658 \(2006\)](#), [1608 \(2005\)](#), [1601 \(2005\)](#), [1576 \(2004\)](#), [1529 \(2004\)](#), and [1542 \(2004\)](#),

Recalling in particular its resolution [2476 \(2019\)](#), which established the United Nations Integrated Office in Haiti (BINUH) beginning on 16 October 2019 based on the report of the Secretary-General of 1 March 2019 (document [S/2019/198](#)),

Reiterating the essential constitutional role of Haiti's Parliament and the urgent need for inclusive inter-Haitian national dialogue to address longstanding drivers of instability by creating a sustainable and commonly accepted framework to permit the organization of free, fair, and transparent legislative elections as soon as technically feasible,

1. *Decides* to extend, to 15 October 2021 the mandate of BINUH in accordance with its resolution [2476 \(2019\)](#), headed by a Special Representative of the Secretary-General of the United Nations, and the reporting requirements specified in resolution [2476 \(2019\)](#);

2. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
