AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA REGARDING THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Resolution Proposed by the Delegation of Poland

The General Assembly resolves:

- 1. To entrust the Secretary-General with making all the necessary arrangements, so that Article V of the Agreement between the United Nations and the United States of America regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations, conforms to international practice and so that, as is the case with diplomatic missions accredited to the governments of the Member States, the refusal to recognize a given official of the delegation be limited to exceptional cases where such action is justified and to this end;
- 2. To recommend to the Secretary-General and to the appropriate authorities of the United States of America to use Section 16 of the General Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations as a guide in considering under Sub-Sections 2 and 4 of Section 15 of the above-mentioned agreement regarding the Headquarters what classes of persons on the staff of delegations might be included in the lists to be drawn up by agreement between the Secretary-General, the Government of the United States and the Government of the Member state concerned.
