Menemen-Izmir (Turkey), 2-8 October 2000

Provisional Agenda and Information concerning the Seminar

This document is an information note for participants. It contains the explanatory notes, the provisional agenda and practical information for the seminar. Attached is a registration form (Annex) which participants are requested to return not later than 15 June 2000.

Please forward this information note to any specialists who may be interested in the seminar topic.

Objectives and Scope of the Seminar

The seminar will offer the opportunity to exchange experience and share state of the art knowledge on recent developments in forest harvesting, trade and marketing practices for non-wood forest products as well as their potential importance for socio-economic development.

It will, in particular, discuss issues on sustainable forest operations and improved utilisation of non-wood forest products as well as the reduction of the environmental impacts and wastes in the forests and processing facilities.

Furthermore, the seminar will deal with the following issues: financial, organisational and administrative support measures by governments, the private sector, non-governmental organisations, to promote the sustainable utilisation of non-wood forest products and its importance for the development, employment and income generation particularly for local populations.

It is expected that the seminar will offer an overview of trends on environmentally friendly forest operations and processing of non-wood forest products, its importance within the forestry sector, changes needed and guidelines for their implementation.

It shall also provide an overview of existing training, education and extension facilities and needs to enhance the promotion of the efficient and reduced impact utilisation of non-wood forest products.

Place and Dates of the Seminar

The seminar will be held from 2 to 8 October 2000 at the International Agro-Hydrology Research and Training Center, Menemen, which is located 30 km northwest of Izmir.

Organization

The seminar is being organised under the auspices of the Joint FAO/ECE/ILO Committee on Forest Technology, Management and Training with the participation of the International Union of Forestry Research Organizations and in cooperation with the Turkish Government.

The seminar is aimed at all those working in the forestry, trade and marketing sectors and in particular, at those dealing with non-wood forest products:

- Scientists, teachers and trainers from universities, forestry schools, vocational training and extension centers;
- S Representatives of non-governmental organisations, forestry and forest products associations and co-operatives;
- S Representatives of decision-making bodies.

Costs

Costs for board and lodging at the International Training Center will be US\$45 per person per day for a single room and US\$70 for two persons in a double room.

A participation fee of US\$ 150 will be charged per participant. This includes organisational costs for the seminar, travel costs for the study visits and fees for entrances for cultural visits.

Participation fee and costs for board and lodging should be paid when registering at the Training Center in Menemen-Izmir upon arrival, in advance for the seminar.

Registration

Participants are requested to send their completed registration form (Annex) not later than 15 June 2000 to the addresses indicated on the form.

Passports and visas

All participants should have a valid passport and, if required, an entry visa, which can be obtained from the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in their own country. Visa applications should be made as early as possible.

Weather

Daytime temperature in October normally varies between 20 to 25° C. and during the night 10 to 15° C.. During the study visits suitable shoes for forest visits will be needed.

Money exchange

Money can be exchanged at banks and money exchange offices. It is advisable to carry banknotes, as sometimes credit cards are not easily accepted. Preferred currencies are US\$ and DM.
