Statement

Il Cenacolo focuses activities on training and counseling for women and girls.

The method used by Il Cenacolo is holistic and multidisciplinary: we use also images in order to be able to communicate with women of every country, religion, culture. The image can communicate in a deep way using a very powerful and universal language. The goal is to achieve an effective capacity-building and empowerment. Il Cenacolo has been working on these issues for 20 years and the experience has given us the evidence that women can reach every kind of result in each field (economical, political, social, scientific ...) if they have a specific training to know their power and their capacities. After this specific training we offer a service of counseling to help women to grow up with their activities. The globalization and the crisis we are living for the covid has helped us to develop e-learning training and counseling.
