Joint Communiqué
On the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations
Between
The Commonwealth of Dominica
And
The People's Republic of Bangladesh

The Government of the Commonwealth of Dominica and the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, in accordance with the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, non-interference in each other's internal affairs and with due respect, regard to equality and mutual benefit, have decided upon mutual recognition for the establishment of diplomatic relations.

The parties have agreed to promote mutual understanding and strengthen friendship and cooperation in the political, economic, social, cultural, scientific, and humanitarian areas.

In accordance with the principles and purpose of the United Nations Charter and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961, the Government the People's Republic of Bangladesh and the Government of the Commonwealth of Dominica agree to exchange Ambassadors as soon as possible, and to provide all necessary assistance and support to the functions of diplomatic missions in their respective capitals on the basis of equality and mutual interest.

This agreement shall come into force upon the date of last notification by both States of the completion of their internal procedures necessary for its entry into force.

Done at *New York, United States of America* on *24 November 2020* in two original copies, in English, both text being equally authentic.
