COMPLETION OF THE WORK OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Report of the General Committee

- 1. The General Committee, at its 64th meeting held on 2 May 1949, decided on the proposal of the President, by 11 votes to 2, to recommend to the General Assembly that 14 May be fixed as the date on which the present session of the General Assembly should be edjourned and that the Committees be urged to adjust their work accordingly.
- 2. A proposal by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics that the General Committee recommend the re-allocation to the ad hoc Political Committee of the item "Treatment of Indians in the Union of South Africa" was rejected by 6 votes to 4, with 3 abstentions.
- 3. A proposal by Poland that the General Committee recommend the re-allocation to the ad hoc Political Committee of the item "Question of Indonesia" was rejected by 7 votes to 2, with 4 abstentions.
