ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AD HOC POLITICAL COMMITTEE

Report of the General Committee

1. The General Committee, at its fiftieth meeting held on 15 November 1948, decided to recommend to the General Assembly that an ad hoc Political Committee, upon which all Members shall have the right to be represented, be established to consider and report on certain items from among those referred to the First Committee by the General Assembly.
2. The General Committee recommends to the General Assembly that the following items be referred to the ad hoc Political Committee:
 1. Report of the Security Council
 2. Admission of New Members
 - (a) Report of the Security Council
 - (b) Advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice
 - (c) Admission to the Organization of Italy and all those States whose applications for membership have obtained seven votes in the Security Council: item proposed by Argentina
 - (d) Application of Ceylon for membership in the United Nations: special report of the Security Council
 3. The problem of voting in the Security Council:
 - (a) Report of the Interim Committee of the General Assembly
 - (b) Convocation of a General Conference under Article 109 of the Charter in order to study the question of the veto in the Security Council: item proposed by Argentina
 4. Advisability of establishing a permanent committee of the General Assembly: report of the Interim Committee of the General Assembly
 5. Study of methods for the promotion of international co-operation in the political field: report of the Interim Committee of the General Assembly
 6. United Nations Guard: item proposed by the Secretary-General
