

Report of the Third Committee

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 18 September 2020, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-fifth session the item entitled "Countering the use of information and communications technologies for criminal purposes" and to allocate it to the Third Committee.
- 2. The Committee, pursuant to the organization of work adopted at its 1st meeting, held on 5 October, and taking into account the prevailing conditions relating to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) on the working arrangements for its seventy-fifth session and the available technological and procedural solutions in the interim period, convened one virtual informal meeting to hear an introductory statement and hold an interactive dialogue on the item jointly with item 111, entitled "Crime prevention and criminal justice", and item 113, entitled "International drug control". The proceedings of the virtual informal meeting are reflected in the annex to document A/75/479.
