AGENDA OF THE THIRD REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Report of the General Committee

1. The General Committee, at its 48th meeting held on 3 November 1948, was notified by the Secretary-General (A/BUR/104) that Mr. Donald C. Stone had resigned from the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, to which he was appointed under the terms of General Assembly resolution 72 (I) of 19 November 1946.

The General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the question of filling the resulting vacancy should be referred to the Fifth Committee under item 36 (a) of the agenda of the third regular session - "Appointments to fill vacancies in the membership of subsidiary bodies of the General Assembly" - already referred to that Committee. 2. The General Committee, at the same meeting, also had before it a request by the Secretary-General for the inclusion of an additional item in the agenda of the third regular session, as follows: International facilities for the promotion of training in public administration" (A/BUR/105).

The Committee recommends that the General Assembly include the item in its agenda, and refer it to the Fifth Committee for consideration and report.
