**Guyana:\* draft resolution**

**Revised estimates relating to the proposed programme budget for 2021 under section 11, United Nations support for the New Partnership for Africa's Development, and section 36, Staff assessment: Office of the Special Adviser on Africa**

*The General Assembly,*

*Having considered* the report of the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General;
2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;
3. *Reaffirms* that the development of Africa is an established priority of the United Nations, and recalls its commitment to address the unique needs of Africa;
4. *Welcomes* the proposal of the Secretary-General on the reorientation and reorganization of the Office of the Special Adviser on Africa, intended to improve efficiencies, strengthen coordination, harmonize programme implementation and provide support for the priorities of the African Union Development Agency-New Partnership for Africa's Development;
5. *Recalls* paragraph 20 of the report of the Advisory Committee, and requests the Secretary-General to submit, through the Committee for Programme and Coordination, a revised proposal for the consideration of the General Assembly at its seventy-sixth session.
