## The General Assembly,

- 1. Takes note of the Report of the Secretary-General on the Feasibility of Establishing a Single Administrative Tribunal (A/C.5/37/23); and
  - 2. Requests the Secretary-General:
- (a) to continue consultations necessary for a progressive harmonization and further development of the statutes, rules and practices of the Administrative Tribunal of the International Labour Organisation of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal, with a view to strengthening the common system and to reducing to the extent possible the associated administrative costs; and
- $(\underline{b})$  to report thereon at a future session of the General Assembly, upon completion of the consultations, with interim reports on the progress of the consultations being submitted to intervening sessions of the General Assembly.
