JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PRINCIPALITY OF LIECHTENSTEIN

The Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka and the Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein,

Desirous of strengthening the existing friendly relations between the two States in various fields,

Guided by the principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, due respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity, international treaties, and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level, on the basis of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.

This Joint Communiqué shall enter into force on the date of signing.
