The meeting was called to order at 11.15 a.m.

ORGANIZATION OF WORK

1. Mr. FAREED (Pakistan), speaking as a Vice-Chairman of the Committee, said that members would recall that at the previous meeting the Committee had agreed to continue its work until the afternoon of Thursday, 16 December 1982. He expressed the hope that the informal consultations to be held that afternoon would lead to agreement on draft resolutions A/C.2/37/L.5 on food problems, A/C.2/37/L.74 on immediate implementation of the Nairobi Programme of Action for the Development and Utilization of New and Renewable Sources of Energy, and A/C.2/37/L.101 on immediate measures in favour of the developing countries.
2. Mr. PAPADATOS (Greece), speaking as a Vice-Chairman of the Committee, announced that the negotiations on item 71 (e) (science and technology for development) would continue that afternoon.
3. The CHAIRMAN said it was clear that, in spite of the efforts made by all delegations, the Committee would need more time to complete its work. It would therefore be necessary to hold a final meeting on Friday, 17 December, in order to take a decision on the outstanding draft resolutions. It would also be necessary to inform the President of the General Assembly in that regard.
