Dear Sir,

Following an in-depth documentary on British television and attending meetings and conferences organized by supporters of a nuclear-free and independent Pacific, I urge the United Nations to insist that the United States renegotiate the Compact to comply with the Trusteeship Agreement, $\underline{1}/$ Belau's Constitution and United Nations General Assembly resolution 1514 (XV).

It would seem obvious that a non-violent observer mission should be sent as a peace-keeping force to Belau as requested by the Ibedul [High Chief Gibbons] and that the Trusteeship Agreement of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands not be terminated until the United States has fulfilled its obligations.
