APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS

Appointment of three members and three alternate members of the
United Nations Staff Pension Committee

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its thirty-first session, the General Assembly, by resolution 31/201 of 22 December 1976, appointed the following persons, for terms of office expiring on 31 December 1979, as members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee:

Members:

Mr. Ernesto Garrido (Philippines)
Mr. Mario Majoli (Italy)
Mr. Michael G. Okeyo (Kenya)

Alternate members:

Mr. Sol Kuttner (United States of America)
Mr. August Marpaung (Indonesia)
Mr. Rudolf Schmidt (Federal Republic of Germany)

2. Accordingly, it will be necessary for the General Assembly at its thirty-fourth session to elect three members and three alternate members to the Committee to serve for a period of three years, beginning on 1 January 1980.

3. At previous sessions, the Fifth Committee, after a secret ballot, submitted to the General Assembly a draft decision containing the names of the persons recommended for appointment. It is suggested that a similar procedure be followed at the thirty-fourth session.
