#### EXPLANATION

ENTRY NUMBER. Documents are referred to by entry numbers in the index to this Check List. Entry numbers do not appear on the documents and should not be used in citations.

LANGUAGE OF ISSUE. The language editions in which a document is issued are indicated as English (E), French (F), Russian (R), Spanish (S), Chinese (C), or bilingual English-French (E&F) texts.

DOCUMENT SYMBOL AND SHORT TITLE. The official document symbol number precedes the title entry. This symbol should be used in citing documents. In the case of publications without document symbol numbers, titles should be cited together with the session number, issue number, supplement number, and column number, whichever is included in the entry. Title entries have been standardized and shortened or expanded in order to clarify the meaning of the titles and the authorship of the documents, so the entries do not always conform literally to the actual documentary titles. The collation shows the pagination of the English or bilingual English-French text only. The date appearing on each document below the document symbol number is usually the date of registration of the documentary text with the Bureau of Documents for publication and translation and should be the same in all language texts. The date of registration closes each entry. Corrigenda and revisions usually are grouped with the parent document in the same entry. Corrigenda are corrections of errors in the text, title, date and classification of documents, emendations of the translation, and additions of omitted text. Addenda include supplementary material, such as annexes,

tables, and other additional communications. Revisions are texts revised through formal amendment, or new editions prepared by the submitting delegation or by the Secretariat.

REPUBLICATION NOTES indicate the republication of whole documents in other documents or in the Official Records. In the case of resolutions only their republication in collected sets is indicated, in the case of draft resolutions no attempt is made to note the inclusion of their texts in the verbatim records of meetings.

RESTRICTED SERIES. Documents of "restricted distribution" are indicated in this Check List by a black dot (•) before the symbol.

INTRODUCTORY NOTES give a short parliamentary history of the Commission and describe briefly each Committee session by session, including the date of its appointment, citing its terms of reference, naming its members and officers, listing its reports and document series symbol (if any), and tabulating its meeting records. The plenary meetings are shown in tables for each session. The tables indicate both published and unpublished meeting records and related press releases. Since drafts for the published meeting records should be deposited as a matter of course in the Archives of the United Nations, the tables under the heading "Archives" show only the unpublished manuscript records deposited in the Archives ("TPV"; "TSR") and the sound recordings ("X").

#### Establishment of the (Nuclear) Economic & Employment Commission

The (Nuclear) Economic and Employment Commission, one of the nuclear functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council was appointed by Economic and Social Council Resolution 1/8, adopted on 16 and 18 February 1948. It was composed of a nucleus of nine members appointed in their individual capacity for a term of office expiring on 31 March 1947. (Actually the Nuclear Commission was replaced by the full Economic and Employment Commission, appointed by Economic and Social Council Resolution 2/5 on 21 June 1948). The Council, at its plenary meetings on 16 and 18 February 1946, appointed seven persons by name as initial members and two additional members to be nominated by Canada and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. Terms of reference: In Resolution 1/8, E.S.C.O.R., first session, Annex 8.

- The Temporary Sub-Commission at its 4th plenary meeting of 2 August 1946 approved the appointment of field teams by the Working Group for Europe and Africa. Terms of reference: In documents E/EMP/Sub.1/11,12,14, entries 32:2,3,4. The teams were set up as follows:
- Field Team for Western Europe. Membership: Czechoslovakia, the Netherlands, Peru, the United Kingdom and the United States of America. Chairman: the representative of Czechoslovakia. It left London on 12 August 1946, visited France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg, and returned to London on 25 August 1946.
- Field Team for Eastern Europe. Membership: Canada, Czechoslovakia, Greece, Norway, Poland, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, the United Kingdom and the United States of America. Chairman: the representative for France. It left London on 11 August 1946, visited Czechoslovakia and Poland, and returned to London on 26 August 1946.
- 137c Field Team for Southern Europe. Membership: France, Greece, the United Kingdom, the United States of America and Yugoslavia. Chairman: the representative for France. It left London on 16 August 1946, visited Greece and Yugoslavia and returned to London on 2 September 1946.

#### Ad hoc Committee

Drafting Committee on the Report of the Working Group for Europe and Africa. Established at the 5th and 6th meetings of the Temporary Sub-Commission on 5 and 9 August 1946, and was set up in London on 26 August 1946.

Terms of reference: In document E/EMP/Sub.1/19, entry 32:5. Membership: Belgium, China, Czechoslovakia, France, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom and the United States of America. Report: In document E/EMP/Sub.1/40, submitted to the 7th meeting of the Temporary Sub-Commission, 6 September 1946.

#### Establishment and Composition

The Economic and Employment Commission, one of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council, was established as a permanent Commission by the Economic and Social Council Resolution 2/5, adopted on 21 June 1946. Terms of reference: In the resolution. (See document E/CN.1/2, entry 151). The Commission consists of one representative from each of fifteen States, Members of the United Nations, selected by the Council. The Council may, in addition, appoint in their individual capacity, from ten to fifteen corresponding members from countries not represented on the Commission. Except for the initial period, the term of office shall be for three years. For the initial period, one-third of the members were elected to serve for two years, one-third for three years and one-third for four years, the term of each member being determined by lot. Retlring members are eligible for re-election. Accordingly, the Council at its 46th plenary meeting on 2 October 1946, elected the fifteen nominating States. The terms of office were determined by lot at the 47th plenary meeting on 3 October 1946, as follows: to serve for two years: Belgium, Brazil, France, Poland, the United Kingdom; to serve for three years: Canada, China, Czechoslovakia, India, Norway; for four years: Australia, the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Cuba, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United States of America. In order to secure a balanced expert representation in the various fields covered by the Commission, the Secretary-General was instructed to consult with the Governments so selected before the representatives were finally nominated by these governments and confirmed by the Council. Accordingly, at an ad hoc meeting on 10 December 1946, the Council confirmed the fourteen nominations submitted by the Secretary-General (document E/252). The Council decided at this meeting with regard to States from which nominations had not been received that members nominated might serve provisionally pending confirmation by the Council at its next session. The member nominated by Poland was therefore confirmed by the Council sitting as a Committee of the Whole on 26 March 1947, as were replacements of the representatives of Canada and India. (See document E/378/Rev.1). A replacement of the representative of Cuba was confirmed at the 225th plenary meeting (document E/987) on 28 August 1948.

At its 202nd and 203rd meetings on 17 and 19 August 1948, the Council filled the vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of office of the first-third of the membership initially appointed for two years, by re-electing France, Poland, the United Kingdom, Belgium and Brazil. The representatives so re-nominated by the elected States, together with a replacement for Cuba, were confirmed by the Council at its 225th meeting on 29 August 1948 (See document E/1308).

At its 315th meeting on 1 August 1949, the Council replaced the second third of the representatives whose term of office was to expire by the end of 1949. China, India, Canada, Czechoslovakia and Norway were re-elected (See document E/1508).
