**Paragraph 5**In the first sentence, *for 153 read 152***Paragraph 8**The third sentence *should read*

Overall, in 2020, in the 152 countries in which UNICEF provided a COVID-19 response, it also responded to 303 new and ongoing humanitarian situations, including 102 natural disasters, 72 sociopolitical crises, 59 health emergencies, 38 nutrition crises and 32 other situations, for a total of 455 humanitarian responses, including the COVID-19 response.

**Paragraph 18**The fifth sentence *should read*

In 63 countries reporting humanitarian crises, a total of 17 million children were vaccinated against measles.

**Paragraph 19**The second sentence *should read*

UNICEF supported the distribution of insecticide-treated nets to 2.5 million people in humanitarian crises, with most distribution taking place in Ethiopia, Somalia and South Sudan.

Progress was also slow in reaching the output milestone related to access to sanitation facilities in humanitarian crises, due to the reprioritization of hygiene and water for the COVID-19 response, compounded by challenges related to movement restrictions during the pandemic.
