SECURITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT SAYS DATE FOR FOREIGN-MINISTER-LEVEL MEETING ON PROBLEMS IN FORMER YUGOSLAVIA WILL BE SET AFTER CONSULTATIONS

Following consultations held this morning, the President of the Security Council, Yuliy M. Vorontsov (Russian Federation), made the following statement to the press:

At present, intensive consultations are taking place between Ministers for Foreign Affairs of several States members of the Security Council on the problems of settlement in former Yugoslavia. These consultations will apparently be going on within the next several days. In these circumstances, there is no possibility to determine definitely the date for the Security Council meeting at the level of Ministers for Foreign Affairs. The date for such a Security Council meeting will be set later, given the results of the consultations.
