Report of Japan on the implementation of Security Council resolution [2571 \(2021\)](#)

1. Travel ban

Based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, the Government of Japan has introduced measures to prevent the entry into Japan or transit through Japanese territory of the 28 individuals designated by the Committee.

2. Asset freeze

Based on the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, the Government of Japan has, with regard to the 23 individuals on the sanctions list, imposed restrictions on payments to them and on capital transactions (deposit, trust and money loan) with them. With regard to the two entities on the list, the Government has imposed restrictions on capital transactions (deposit and trust) with them.
