Letter dated 29 May 1979 from the Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

In my capacity as Chairman of the Arab Group during the month of May 1979, have the honour to refer to the resolutions of the Council of the League of rab States which were adopted by our Ministers for Foreign Affairs, Economy and inance at Baghdad on 31 March 1979, and in particular paragraph 7 of those esolutions which reads as follows:

"Member countries shall undertake to notify all foreign countries about their stand vis-a-vis the Egyptian-Zionist treaty and to call on these countries to refrain from supporting this treaty since it constitutes an aggression on the rights of the Palestinian people and the Arab nation, and is a threat to peace and security in the world."

The Arab Group, accordingly, is opposed to any direct or indirect action sich any principal or subsidiary organ of the United Nations, including the curity Council, may take which would either confer any legitimacy whatsoever or interpreted to grant recognition, express or implied, to the Egyptian-Israelicate treaty.
