

Letter dated 13 December 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to transmit herewith Mediation and Security Council Decision A/DEC. 02/11/21 of the Authority of Heads of State and Government of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), adopted in Accra on 7 November 2021, imposing targeted sanctions against the transitional authorities and all other persons preventing the return to constitutional order in Mali (see annex), together with a letter from the President of the ECOWAS Commission, Jean-Claude Kassi Brou, requesting the support of the United Nations in the implementation of those sanctions (see enclosure).

I should be grateful if you would bring the present letter and its annex to the attention of the members of the Security Council.

Extraordinary session of the Mediation and Security Council at the level of Heads of State and Government of the Economic Community of West African States, Accra, Ghana, 7 November 2021

Mediation and Security Council Decision A/DEC. 02/11/2021 imposing targeted sanctions against the transitional authorities and all other persons preventing the return to constitutional order in Mali

The Mediation and Security Council,

Having regard to article 58 on regional security of the Revised Treaty of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS),

Having regard to the ECOWAS Declaration of Political Principles adopted on 6 July 1991,

Having regard to articles 10, 11 and 12, concerning the Mediation and Security Council at the level of member States, of the ECOWAS Protocol relating to the Mechanism for Conflict Prevention, Management, Resolution, Peacekeeping and Security signed in Lomé on 10 December 1999,

Having regard to the Protocol on Democracy and Good Governance signed in Dakar on 21 December 2001.

Having regard to Supplementary Act A/SA.13/02/12 of 17 February 2012 on the imposition of sanctions against member States that do not honour their obligations towards ECOWAS,

Considering the Principles set forth in the Solemn Declaration of the Organization of African Unity Conference on Security, Stability, Development and Cooperation in Africa, adopted in Abuja on 8 and 9 May 2000, as well as Decision AHG.DEC.142 (XXXV) on the framework for the response of the Organization of African Unity to unconstitutional changes of government, adopted in Algiers in July 1999,

Considering that on 18 August 2020, a military junta, the Comité national pour le salut du peuple, seized power in Mali by overthrowing the democratically elected President, His Excellency Ibrahim Boubacar Keita,

Noting the lack of progress made in the preparations for the elections, including the absence of a detailed timetable of activities for the conduct of elections on the agreed dates,

Considering that failure to hold the elections on time would call into question the fundamental pillars of ECOWAS and violate the provisions of article 2, paragraph 2 (i), of Supplementary Act A/SA.13/02/12, which calls for respect for and the protection of human rights, the rule of law, democracy and constitutional order,

Noting that the heightened political uncertainties in Mali have led to the deterioration of the security situation in the country, which is likely to jeopardize the peace and stability of Mali and the ECOWAS region,

Convinced that the imposition of targeted sanctions is likely to create an atmosphere conducive to the restoration of constitutional order and the rule of law, as well as to the maintenance of peace and the territorial integrity of Mali,

Decides:

Article 1. Targeted sanctions

Sanctions shall be imposed against identified individuals and groups, including the members of the transitional authorities and the other transitional institutions. The sanctions shall also apply to their families.

The sanctions shall consist of:

- · Freezing of financial assets
- Travel ban

Article 2. List of persons under sanctions

The list of persons under sanctions is contained in annex A to the present Decision.

Article 3. Review of the list of persons under sanctions

The President of the Commission may, depending on the evolution of the sociopolitical situation in Mali, propose changes to the list and send those changes to the Mediation and Security Council for a decision.

Article 4. Notification of the list of persons under sanctions

The President of the Commission shall apprise the Malian authorities, the member States, the ECOWAS institutions, the United Nations, the African Union, bilateral and multilateral partners and all entities involved in the implementation of the sanctions of the list of persons under sanctions.

Article 5. Entry into force and publication

- 1. Mediation and Security Council Decision A/DEC.2/11/2021 shall enter into force upon signature by the Chair of the Authority of Heads of State and Government.
- 2. The Decision shall be published in the official gazette of ECOWAS upon signature by the Chair of the Authority of Heads of State and Government. It shall also be published in the official gazette of each member State upon notification by the Commission.

Enclosure

On 7 November 2021, the Heads of State and Government of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), at an extraordinary session of the Mediation and Security Council, decided to impose sanctions against identified individuals and groups, including the members of the transitional authorities and the other transitional institutions of Mali. Under the sanctions regime, the listed individuals, as well as their families, are subject to a travel ban and the freezing of their financial assets.

To ensure the effective implementation of the sanctions, which are intended to promote a rapid return to constitutional order, the Authority of Heads of State and Government calls on the Security Council to endorse and support the implementation of the sanctions. I would therefore welcome any measures you might wish to take to that effect.
