# JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

#### BETWEEN

### THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS

### AND

## THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH SUDAN

The Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of South Sudan,

Desiring to develop mutually beneficial relations and co-operation between the two countries,

Guided by the principles and purposes enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law,

Reaffirming their adherence and commitment to the promotion of international peace and security, respect for the sovereignty, territorial integrity and independence of States, and non-interference in their internal affairs,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations, at the ambassadorial level, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué.
