Resumed twenty-second session

AGENDA FOR THE RESUMED TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

Note by the Secretary-General

I

For the convenience of the Council, the Secretary-General sets out below annotations to the items on the agenda of the resumed twenty-second session, which is expected to take place in the second half of December:

19.\* Confirmation of members of functional commissions of the Council

The Secretary-General will submit to the Council for confirmation the names of representatives of members of functional commissions nominated or renominated since the close of the twenty-first session.

20. Elections

Under this item the Council is required:

- (a) to elect the seven members of the Council Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations, in accordance with rule 82 of the rules of procedure as revised at the eighteenth session;
- (b) subject to the decision to be taken by the General Assembly on the draft resolution recommended for its adoption by the Third Committee (see A/3397), to elect thirteen members of the Executive Board of UNICEF.<sup>1/</sup> The Secretary-General will issue a working paper on the subject of this election.

21. Work of the Council in 1957

In accordance with Council resolution 557 B IV (XVIII), the agenda for the resumed part of the session includes:

\* Items 1 to 18, part of item 20 and item 22 of the agenda for the twenty-second session (E/2875 and Add.1) were dealt with at the first part of the session.

- (a) allocation of items to sessions of the Council during the forthcoming year on the basis of a draft programme submitted by the Secretary-General;
- (b) the establishment of dates for opening debate on items allocated to the twenty-third session;
- (c) the disposal of items arising out of the eleventh regular session of the General Assembly.

The Secretary-General has prepared a draft programme (E/L.739) for the Council's consideration.

## II

The Secretary-General calls to the attention of the Council his note (E/2935) in which he suggests that the Council may wish to consider the desirability of negotiating, at the resumed twenty-second session, a draft agreement between the United Nations and the International Finance Corporation.
