

2. Election of officers

Rule 103 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly provides that committees other than Main Committees shall elect a Chair, one or more Vice-Chairs and a Rapporteur. These officers shall be elected on the basis of equitable geographical distribution, experience and personal competence. The Bureau of the Committee on Conferences comprises a Chair, three Vice-Chairs and a Rapporteur.

At its organizational session for 1989, held on 1 March 1989, the Committee agreed in principle that thenceforth the role of Chair would rotate annually among the regional groups. At its substantive session of 2021, the Committee agreed in principle that the Chair would undertake informal consultations with a view to determining the composition of the Bureau for 2022 and that the Chair and the other members of the Bureau would continue in their capacities until the 2022 Bureau had been elected.

4. Organization of work for 2022: intersessional departures and related matters

The Committee will consider requests for intersessional departures in accordance with paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 46/190, in which the Assembly took note of the guidelines adopted by the Committee (A/46/32, para. 77), and in accordance with the decisions taken by the Committee at its 373rd meeting, on 26 August 1994, at its 379th meeting, on 23 March 1995, and at its substantive session of 1995.

In accordance with legislative mandates, the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management will administer the programme of meetings as stated in the report of the Secretary-General on improving the performance of the Department (A/57/289, para. 15).

Moreover, meetings of the Committee may be required under the terms of paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 35/10 A, by which the Assembly decided that all proposals affecting the schedule of conferences and meetings made at sessions of the Assembly should be reviewed by the Committee when administrative implications were being considered under the requirements of rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the Assembly.

5. Programme of work for 2022

At its 560th meeting, on 13 September 2021, the Committee decided that the substantive session of 2022 would be held from 6 to 12 September 2022.

The information requested by the General Assembly in resolution 76/237 of 24 December 2021 on the pattern of conferences will be presented in a consolidated report of the Secretary-General on the pattern of conferences. Statistical and other relevant data will be presented as information supplementary to the report.

6. Adoption of the agenda for the substantive session of 2022

At its organizational session for 2021, the Committee adopted the provisional agenda for its substantive session of 2021 and requested the Secretariat to submit to it at its organizational session for 2022 a provisional agenda for its substantive session of 2022.

The annex to the present document contains a provisional agenda for the substantive session of 2022. The provisional agenda takes into account standing mandates from the Committee and the General Assembly, as well as the sections and information requested by the Assembly in its resolution 76/237.

2. Organization of work

The terms of reference of the Committee are set forth in paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 43/222 B of 21 December 1988.

In section II.A, paragraph 20, of its resolution 57/283 B, the General Assembly encouraged the Committee to keep under continued review the procedures for the participation of observers in the work of the Committee.

3. General discussion

(a) Calendar of conferences and meetings

The draft calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2023 will be prepared pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 12 of General Assembly resolution 76/237 of 24 December 2021 on the pattern of conferences.

The Secretariat will compile a list of requests for intersessional departures from the approved calendar of conferences and meetings for 2022, together with information on any action taken by the Committee.

The Secretariat will report on requests received pursuant to paragraph 15 of General Assembly resolution 47/202 A and section I, paragraph 7, of Assembly resolution 40/243, for action by the Committee.
