**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ  
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN  
THE FEDERATION OF SAINT CHRISTOPHER (SAINT KITTS)  
AND NEVIS  
AND  
THE REPUBLIC OF THE SUDAN**

The Government of the Federation of Saint Christopher and Nevis and the Government of the Republic of the Sudan, desirous of developing and strengthening diplomatic relations between both countries and seeking to promote economic and cultural links;

Recognising in particular principles of sovereign equality and territorial integrity, both countries have decided to formalise diplomatic relations in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, dated 18 April 1961 and on the basis of the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this joint Communiqué in the English language.
