Sir,

I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 9th July, 1947, and to inform you that His Hashimite Majesty's Government, in view of the fact that they are not a member of the UNO, are not prepared to send a delegate to give evidence before the United Nations Special Committee on Palestine outside Transjordan.

2- In the meantime I am instructed to inform you as well that my Government would warmly welcome the Committee or any member or members should they desire to pay a visit for that purpose to Transjordan.
