I request that the rights of the Belauan peoples be upheld by the United Nations.

The people of Belau have repeatedly expressed their desire to follow a path of self-determination that is free from external influence. Their just and legal right to follow such a course must be respected.

I ask that you do all in your power to ensure that the United States of America honours its responsibilities under the Trusteeship Agreement $\underline{1}/$ and respects the Belauans' rights to self-determination.
