SECRETARY-GENERAL ATTENDS MOSCOW LUNCHEON

Secretary-General Trygve Lie attended in Moscow at 11:00 a.m. local time today (Monday) a lunch given in his honor by Andrei Y. Vyshinsky, Soviet Foreign Minister. Among the guests were Constantin E. Zinchenko, UN Assistant Secretary-General in charge of Security Council Affeirs, Deputy Foreign Minister Andrei A. Gromyko, Arkady A. Sobolev, Mr. Zinchenko's predecessor as Assistant Secretary-General, Alexei N. Roschin, Chief of the United Nations Division in the Soviet Foreign Office, Fedor Molotchkov, Chief of Protocol of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ivan Lobenov, Mr. Vyshinsky's assistant, Vsevolod Pastoev, an official of the Foreign Ministry Protocol Office, Michail S. Vavilov, Director of the United Nations Information Center in Moscow, Helge Akre, Norwegian Charge d'Affaires in the Soviet capital, Olav Rytter, Director of the United Nations Information Center in Prague, who accompanied Mr. Lie to Moscow, and Miss Ingrid Berntzen, Mr. Lie's private secretary.
