SECRETARY-GENERAL VISITS EGYPTIAN PERSONALITIES IN CAIRO

(The following was received here from the UN Information Center, Cairo.)

On 19 April at 10:30 a.m. Secretary-General Trygve Lie and his party signed the registry at the Royal Palace in Cairo and presented their respects to His Majesty the King of Egypt. Mr. Lie then visited Salaheddine Bey, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Egypt, and Azzam Pasha, Secretary-General of the Arab League, with whom he had luncheon.

After a visit to Nahas Pasha, Prime Minister of Egypt, Mr. Lie and his party attended a dinner given by the Foreign Minister. Present at both the luncheon and dinner were Cabinet Ministers, Ministers of Arab states, high Egyptian Government officials and representatives of specialized agencies.

On 20 April Mr. Lie visited Ahmed Hussein Bey, Minister of Social Affairs, who accompanied the Secretary-General and Mrs. Lie on a visit to the social center in Sindyoun near Cairo, then to an institute for treating children of families with tuberculosis. After attending a luncheon given by the Minister of Social Affairs, the Secretary-General and his party took tea at the country house of Hafez Afifi Pasha, formerly Foreign Minister and President of the Security Council while he was representative of Egypt on that body.
