SECRETARY-GENERAL TO SIGN AGREEMENTS CONCERNING GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN PARIS

(The following was received here from the United Nations Information Center in Paris.)

Secretary-General Trygve Lie arrived in Paris last night from Geneva, accompanied by Andrew Cordier, his Executive Assistant, Shamaldharee Lall, Assistant Secretary-General for Conference and General Services, and A. H. Feller, United Nations General Counsel and Principal Director of the Legal Department.

Today Mr. Lie visited Guy de la Tournelle, Director of the Political Affairs Section of the French Foreign Office, who received Mr. Lie in the absence of Alexandre Parodi, Secretary-General of the Foreign Office.

Tomorrow, at 10:30 a.m. Paris time, Mr. Lie will sign agreements covering arrangements for the sixth regular session of the General Assembly to be convened in Paris on 6 November. Foreign Minister Robert Schuman will sign for the French Government. The signing will take place at the French Foreign Office.

Mr. Lie is scheduled to leave Paris for London at 3:00 p.m. tomorrow from le Bourget airport.
